- The Board discussed a timeline for the next meeting and setting a public hearing. The Board will hold a meeting and workshop July 15th to work on the plan and incorporate what the public has recommended. The public hearing date will be discussed at the July meeting.

There is approximately \$50,000 worth of equipment he would donate.
